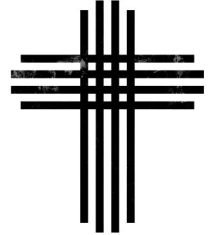


# Christ Church, New Catton

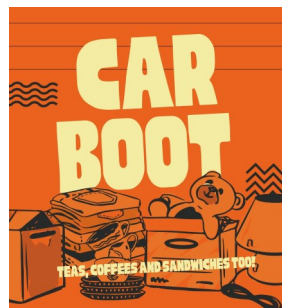
